WHAT YOU SEE FESTIVAL

With a program fueled with urgency and joy, the multidisciplinary and international What You See Festival stretches deep ingrained norms of gender identity through dance, theatre, film, exhibitions, music and more. The second edition of this festival will take place from 22 till 24 November in Utrecht and on the 22nd and the 23rd of November we offer a workshop of Peggy Olislaegers to students and alumni from Theatre- and Dance educations as well as from Gender and Theatre Studies.

THE WORKSHOP

Together with dance activist and international advisor Peggy Olislaegers you'll explore the potential of embracing multiple perspectives. Through physical/performative exercises as well as exercises in dialogue you'll dive in your own questions on the world we live in and the positions you take. The workshop offers tools to shift these positions - professional as well as personal - and to create alternatives for the identity society might put on you. It's a playful but confronting practice in empathy, an exploration of one's identity and an invitation to articulate where you want to be responsible for. The workshop consists of working sessions and visits to several performances of What You See Festival.

PEGGY OLISLAEGERS

Peggy Olislaegers (1966) is one of the leading independent dance dramaturges in Europe, providing artistic and strategic advice for both choreographers and institutes in the performing arts. She became an established adviser during her directorship of the Dutch Dance Festival (2010-2016), developing innovative European projects like *Act Your Age*, *Performing Gender* and *Pivot Dance*, and has advised choreographers and institutes in the UK, Italy, Germany, France, Belgium, Taiwan and NL. Working in the field of ballet, contemporary dance and hiphop, Peggy Olislaegers is known for her ability to connect disciplines, and her articulate knowledge of dance and movement.
